TEST PREPARATION CLASSES

Beginning this year, adults in California will have three options for earning the High School Equivalency Certificate. The three tests that will qualify you for the Certificate are:

- **HiSET:** The High School Equivalency Test (both paper-based and computer-based formats) - Web site: hiset.ets.org
- **GED:** The new version of the GED tests (computer-based) – www.ged.com
- **TASC:** The Test Assessing Secondary Completion (paper-based and computer-based) – www.ctb.com

These tests will be offered at different test centers, but any of these three tests will qualify you for the California High School Equivalency Certificate. Morgan Hill Community Adult School plans to offer HiSET in the near future. Other test centers will administer GED and TASC.

Test Preparation classes will prepare you for the skills you need for success on these tests. Our Test Preparation classes meet on:

Test Preparation New Students Workshops:

To take a Test Preparation class at our school, you must pre-register for a New Students Workshop and take assessments in English and Math skills. The processing/assessment fee is \$20. The first workshops for the 2014-15 school year will be:

GED Testing

Until the state finalizes agreements with the HiSET and TASC—and this is expected to happen in May 2014—the only option available for test-takers is the GED.

To register to take the GED Tests, you must go to the official GED Testing Service web site at **www.GED.com**. Click on the yellow arrow that says “**Schedule Now on MyGED™**.” Sign up for **MyGED** by entering your e-mail address and creating a password. On **MyGED Dashboard**, you will find the locations of test centers and a yellow button that will allow you to begin scheduling the test.

At present, the closest GED test centers are at Silicon Valley Adult Education (760 Hillsdale, San Jose 95136) and Watsonville/Aptos Adult Education (294 Green Valley Road, Watsonville 95076).
